Criteria/Guidelines

Introduction

The Uniting Church in Australia Property Trust (Victoria) is trustee of the 'John and Alexander McLennan Fund' which was established by the Will of the late Alexander Murdoch Matheson McLennan formerly of Fern Grove Farm, Muroon who died on 28 April, 1953.

Half of the income of the Fund is to be used for educating sons of Ministers of The Uniting Church in Australia, operating in Victoria, and half for educating and training boys who are the sons of parents in poor circumstance for farming and agricultural pursuits.
