Mark Scandrette is convinced that Jesus has in mind something active and lively for us: a transformative community where our formation takes place not only in our heads but in our hearts and our bodies, and in the company of one another, in a way that blesses the world we've been entrusted with. What might it be like to engage people who wouldn't come to church, and come up with something to practice together that relates to a felt need – to seek abundant life together through experiments that transform individual lives and the communities in which we live?

Mark Scandrette is an author, teacher, activist and coach for leaders and teams who want to create a better world from the inside out. He is the founding director of ReImagine: A Center for Integral Christian Practice, where he leads an annual series of retreats, workshops and projects designed to help participants apply spiritual wisdom to everyday life. His multidisciplinary studies in applied psychology, family health and theology have shaped his approach to learning and transformation.
